## **POLICIES & PROCEDURES**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. ClubHouse Academy facility hours are Monday/Wednesday/Friday 10:00am – 8:30pm; Tuesday/Thursday 10:00am – 8:00pm; Saturday 9:00am – 2:00pm. There is no adult supervisor before or after these times. The Police Department will be called to pick up children remaining after hours. Holiday office hours may vary.
2. Clubhouse Academy & Sports Leagues will be closed in observance of holidays on the following dates or the date the holiday is observed: Labor Day (9/2), Thanksgiving and the day following (11/28 & 11/29), Christmas Eve (12/24) closed at 2pm, Christmas (12/25), New Year's Day (1/1), President's Day (2/17), and Memorial Day (5/25).
3. Parents are responsible for dropping off and picking up their children on time. Parents are encouraged to pick up their children in the program area. Loitering by the entrance is prohibited.
4. The Boys & Girls Club offers volunteer opportunities and participates in various job training programs. Participants in these programs work directly in our program areas assisting our regular staff. Volunteers and job training participants are not part of our maintained facility staff ratios.

### **PAYMENT AND CONTRACT INFORMATION**

5. All children must be members of the Boys and Girls Clubs of Huntington Valley. Membership cost is \$25.00 and is valid September 1, 2019 - August 31, 2020.
6. Membership, class fees, and sports registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
7. **Delinquency in payment will prohibit your child's ability to attend the program. Delinquent accounts will be reviewed and may be referred to a collection agency.**
8. A \$25.00 service charge will be collected for all returned checks.
9. You have the option to pay online for your program fees/tuition. A convenience fee will apply to all online payments.
10. NO deductions in program fees or pro-rating will be made for holidays, vacations, absences, or missed classes. For missed classes, make-up classes may be available according to each instructor's policy. Classes that fall on the holidays listed above are not subject to make-ups.
11. Sports league fees are due at time of registration for the season.
12. Class fees are paid by the calendar month. Class fees are due by the 1st of the month and are considered late if received after the **due date. We highly encourage you to plan ahead and make payments before the end of the month or on the last day of your class.** A late fee of \$10.00 will be added **after the 1st** to all past due accounts.
13. Fees for private lessons are due in advance and are non-refundable.

### **MEDICAL INFORMATION**

14. In the event of an emergency, the Club has my permission to administer first aid or obtain emergency medical treatment in the child's best interest. I agree to pay any and all expenses incurred due to an emergency involving my child. THE TELEPHONE IS FOR EMERGENCY USE ONLY. Parents and children should make ride arrangements before arriving. Staff cannot give messages.

## **CLUB POLICIES**

- 15.** The Boys & Girls Club has a policy of zero tolerance for violence and sexual harassment. If anyone engages in any sexual harassment at the Club, violence at the Club, or threatens violence at the Club, his or her membership will be terminated immediately.
- 16.** The Boys & Girls Club is not responsible for lost money or belongings. Please mark all articles brought to the facility. Place money in pockets, socks, wrist packs or fanny packs. We HIGHLY discourage handheld game devices, collectibles, iPods, cell phones, and tablets. The Boys & Girls Club is not responsible for lost or damaged items.
- 17.** Misuse of cameras, cell phones, or other internet enabled devices may result in disciplinary action including suspension and revocation of Club membership. Misuse includes, but is not limited to, photographing of members, staff, or club property, inappropriate emails, texts, social media posts, etc..
- 18.** All adults in the building must abide by the policies and procedures of the Club.
- 19.** If you have a concern, complaint, or special need, please make an appointment to discuss it with your child's instructor, coach or the ClubHouse Academy Director. The Boys & Girls Club maintains a professional environment. Our staff members are respectful of parents and parents are expected to be respectful of the staff as well. Yelling and cursing will not be tolerated.
- 20.** Should the Unit Director determine that your child cannot adjust to the program offered or any of your contract agreement is not fulfilled, your child will be withdrawn from the program and your contract will be terminated without refund.
- 21.** The Boys & Girls Clubs of Huntington Valley, Inc. is an equal opportunity employer. No person will, on the basis of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program.
- 22.** This agreement may be changed by the Club at any time to comply with government regulations or for any other reason.

## **SPORTS LEAGUE POLICIES**

- 23.** Teams are organized based on individual player evaluation and team availability. While the Athletics Department may consider requests made by league participants, there is no guarantee that requests will be granted.
- 24.** Teams may be required to play on non-scheduled days or times to complete the season in a timely manner.

## **CLUBHOUSE ACADEMY POLICIES**

- 25.** Children that are dropped off for class are encouraged to stay inside the ClubHouse Academy until they are picked up.
- 26.** Children misbehaving or disrupting class may be asked to sit out for part of the class. If behavior continues your child may be sent to the office and you will be called to come and pick them up.
- 27.** Family members are welcome to sit in the classroom and observe. However, if your presence is disruptive you will be asked to sit in the lobby.
- 28.** Children should always attend class wearing the proper attire.  
**Dance:** Leotard, shorts/skirt, class appropriate shoes.  
**Gymnastics:** Leotard, shorts, long hair pulled back.  
**Martial Arts:** Uniforms can be obtained through the instructors.

## **TRANSPORTATION POLICIES**

- 29.** All children participating in the Boys & Girls Club's ClubHouse Academy Transportation Program must follow the Transportation Program Rules as follows.
  - Seat belts must be worn at all times when the bus is in motion.
  - No eating or drinking is allowed on the bus. NO EXCEPTIONS.
  - No animals allowed on the bus. NO EXCEPTIONS.
  - No standing on the bus when the bus is in motion.
  - No changing seats on the bus.
  - No yelling or loud talking is allowed on the bus. No foul language.
  - All body parts must be kept inside the bus at all times while the bus is in motion.
  - Keep aisle clear at all times.
  - No large boxes or packages. Please make other arrangements to transport these items.



- All personal items including cell phones and electronic devices are to be put away while on the bus.
- No fighting or horseplay. No arguing or bullying.
- Any vandalism to the bus will be paid for by that member's parents/guardians.
- Shirts and shoes are required to ride the bus. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- If a bus rider violates transportation program rules, the following consequences are in place: 1st notice: Written warning  
2nd notice: 1 day suspension from bus program 3rd notice: 3 day suspension from bus program 4th notice: Dismissal from the bus program. **Signed citations MUST be returned to the Transportation Director or bus driver for continued bus riding privileges.** Please call us anytime if you have any questions or concerns.
